

Regarding masking in the building—effective April 1, 2022

- Masking is welcomed and encouraged but not required in the building.
- The new HVAC system in the sanctuary has been installed. Masks are no longer required for any parts of worship services in the sanctuary, including while singing.
- The section of pews to the right (north) as you enter the sanctuary will remain reserved for social distancing, and masks will be required in that section. Please sit in that section and/or leave the sanctuary during singing if it feels safer for you. In the other two sections of pews, social distancing markers have been removed.
- Singing is also allowed without masks at the contemporary worship service in the Fellowship Hall since filtration in that part of the building and the opening of all doors and windows provide safe airflow.
- For the time being, these protocols will not change:
 - ◇ COVID-19 vaccines are recommended and encouraged
 - ◇ Use hand sanitizer upon entering the building
 - ◇ Sign in for contact tracing
 - ◇ Wear a colored dot during worship to indicate comfort level of distancing
 - ◇ Communion during worship will be distributed to take back to your seat to consume
 - ◇ The 9am worship service will be livestreamed for those who prefer to stay at home
 - ◇ Stay home (isolate/quarantine) if feeling sick and get tested if you have symptoms or have been exposed to COVID-19
- This plan will be reconsidered by CLC Council if COVID-19 levels begin to rise again in our county or if WA State requirements change.
